

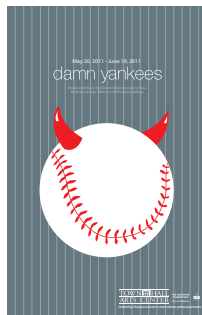
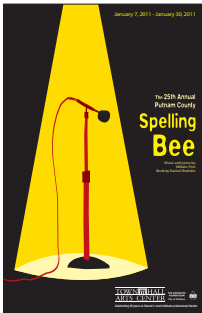
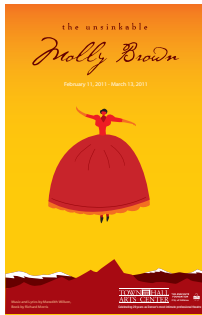

What We Do

The mission of the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center is to enrich the cultural, social and educational life of the community through professionally produced live theatre, concerts and other cultural experiences and special programming for children.

Attendance for all 164 performances this season totaled nearly 34,000, with over 3,300 attending Town Hall Arts Center for the first time this season. Preview performances of each main stage musical were attended by over 650 underprivileged individuals served by ArtReach, Above and Beyond, Star Reach and Colorado Center for the Blind.

Awards

Town Hall Arts Center received 15 nominations for 2011 Henry Awards and was awarded "Outstanding Musical Theatre Production" for *Rent*, and Donna Debrecini and Mary Dailey were awarded "Outstanding Musical Direction" for *Chicago*.

Town Hall Children's Programming

Attendance at 28 children's theatre performances of *Aesop-A-Rebop* in the fall and spring totaled 2,378. Two of these spring performances were shadowed by sign-language interpreters and were attended by students from the Rocky Mountain School for the Deaf and Colorado School for Deaf and Blind. Another 2,178 persons attended 17 summer and holiday performances of *Seussical, Jr.* Approximately 700 disadvantaged children were able to see our children's theatre productions in 2010-11 free of charge or at lower cost thanks to our foundation and governmental grants.

We also held multiple sessions of our **Actors' Playground** -- children's theatre workshop classes for ages 6 – 15, (six summer sessions, two fall sessions, five winter/spring sessions) that served 202 students.

Our outreach program, **Arts on the Move**, took 51 performances and workshops offsite to schools, day care centers and other venues, reaching over 5,500 participants who would not have experienced our children's theatre activities otherwise.

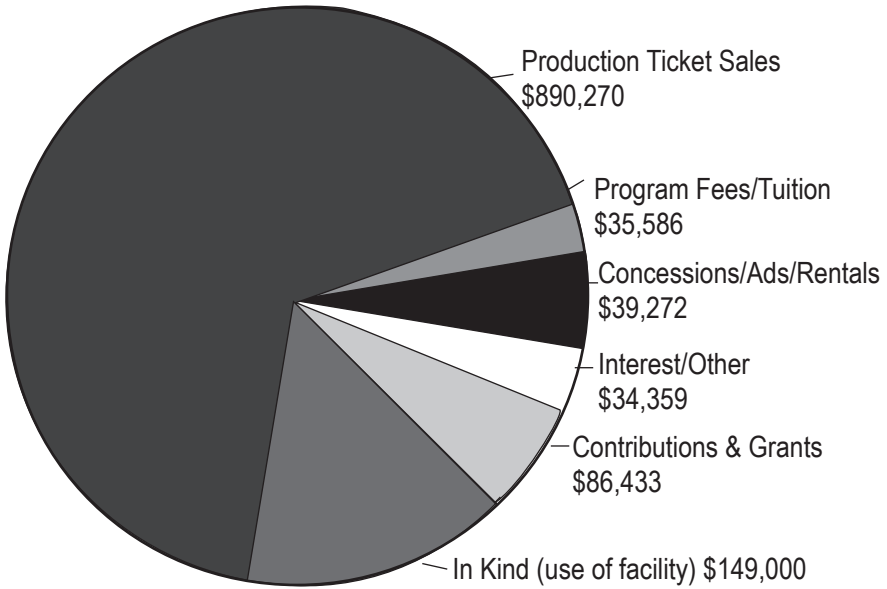

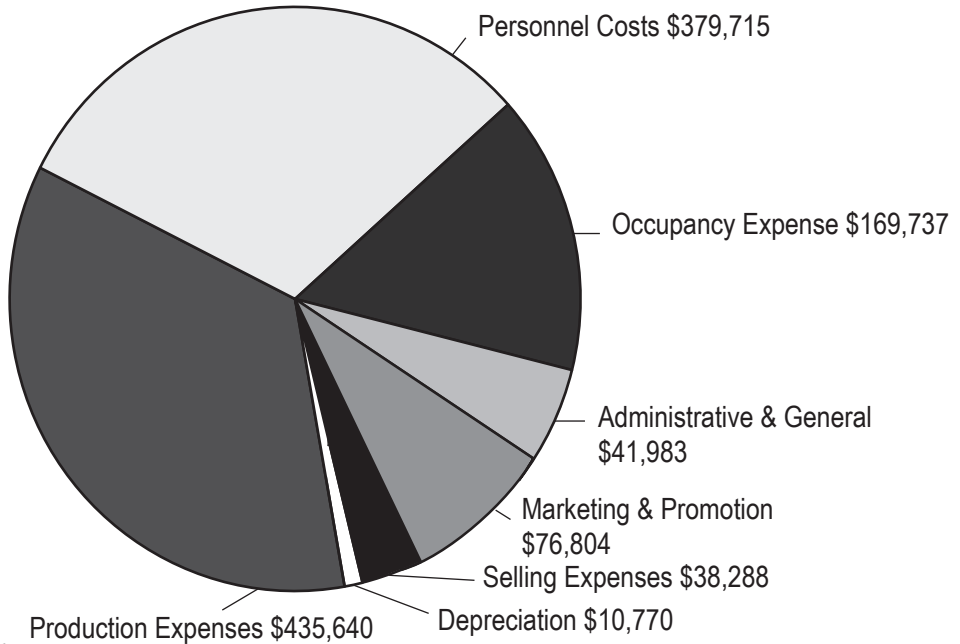
