Town Hall Arts Center Presents *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*

LITTLETON – The next production in Town Hall Arts Center’s 30th Anniversary Season will be *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, with book by Burt Shevelove and Larry Gelbart and music and lyrics by Stephen Sondheim. This popular farce is directed by **Robert Wells**, with musical direction and tracks by **Donna Debreceni** and choreography by **Nick Sugar**. This light, fast-paced, witty, irreverent show is one of the funniest musicals every written. It takes comedy back to its roots, combining situations from the time-tested 2000-year-old comedies of Roman playwright Plautus with the infectious energy of classic vaudeville.

Town Hall’s production opens **January 13, 2012 and runs through February 5, 2012**. Show times are **Thursdays, Fridays & Saturdays at 7:30 p.m.; Saturdays (1/21, 2/4) at 2pm; Sundays at 2 p.m. & 6:30 (1/29, 2/5)**. The cast is headed by local favorite Scott McLean (*Pseudolus*), and includes Drew Hirschboeck, Jacque Jo Billings, Tim Fishbaugh, Damon Guerrasio, Carla Kaiser Kotrc, Stephen Maestas, Nicole Kandelind, Keegan Flaugh, Rob Janzen, Melissa Morris, Anna Gibson, Norell Moore, Kelsey Rich, Lisa Finnerty, Benji Schirm, Chris Russell and Joe Majestic.

Scott McLean returns to Town Hall Arts Center as Pseudolus, the fast-talking, quip-prone slave who’s the comic motor that drives *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* after a very successful run in *White Christmas* in 2010, and *Evita* in 2011. Scott tells us, “I love working at Town Hall. I did my first show here in 2005. The houses are always packed at Town Hall, and that’s a real treat for the performers. The intimate space at Town Hall is exciting. It’s very different than performing at a traditional proscenium space. The audience immediately becomes a character in the show, and it’s great to have their energy so close to the production.”
