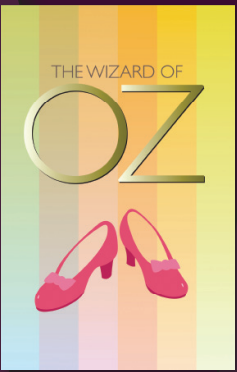
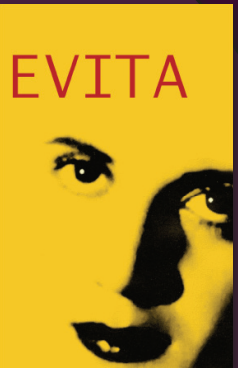
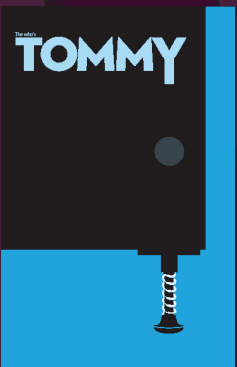

## 2011-12 30th Anniversary Season Schedule

### Evita September 16, 2011 – October 16, 2011

*Lyrics by Tim Rice, Music by Andrew Lloyd Webber*

Argentina's controversial First Lady is the subject of this dynamic musical masterpiece. Driven by ambition and blessed with charisma, Eva Peron was destined to leave a fascinating political legacy unique in the 20th century. Told through a compelling score that fuses haunting chorales with exuberant Latin, pop and jazz influences, Evita creates an arresting theatrical portrait as complex as the woman herself.

### A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum January 13, 2012 – February 5, 2012

*Book by Burt Shevelove and Larry Gelbart, Music and Lyrics by Stephen Sondheim*

Broadway's greatest farce is light, fast-paced, witty, irreverent and one of the funniest musicals ever written. This perfect escape from life's troubles takes comedy back to its roots, combining situations from time-tested, 2000 year old comedies of Roman playwright Plautus with the infectious energy of classic vaudeville. ### Brigadoon February 17, 2012 – March 18, 2012

*Book and Lyrics by Alan Jay Lerner, Music by Frederick Loewe*

A Scottish fantasy about a mysterious village that disappears into the Highland mist and returns for only one day every one hundred years. To the villagers, the magical passing of each century seems no longer than one night. This tribute to simplicity, true love and goodness, has been revived on Broadway several times and has earned both a Tony Award and the New York Drama Critics Circle Award.

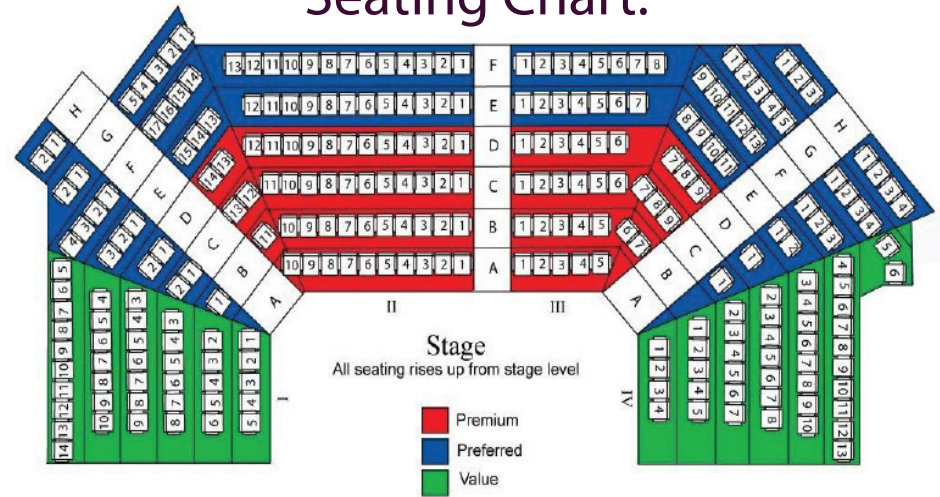
